## Internet Learning

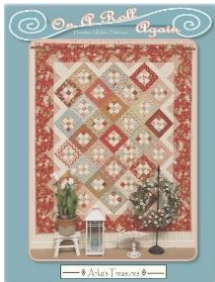

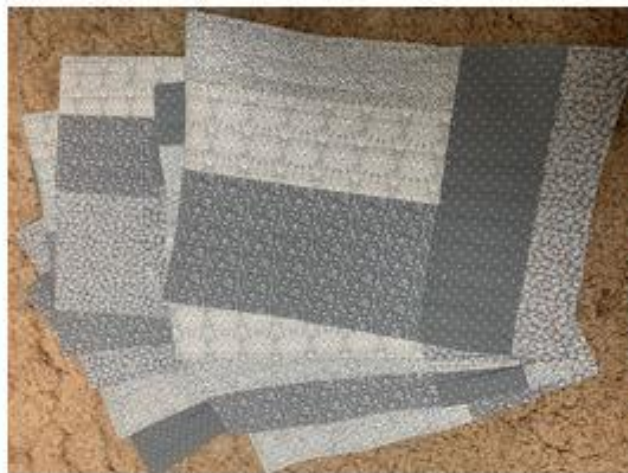
